NOTIFICATION

Bangalore, dated 5th May 1964

G.S.R. 146:- In exercise of the powers conferred by the proviso to article 309 of the Constitution and with the approval of the Government of India as required by the proviso to sub-section (7) of Section 115 of the States Re-organization Act, 1956 (Central Act of 37 of 1956), the Governor of Mysore hereby makes the following rules, namely :-

1. These Rules may be called the Mysore Secretariat Services (Deputation of Under Secretaries to Government for field Experience) Rules, 1964.-

2. Notwithstanding anything contained in the Mysore Secretariat Services (Recruitment) Rules, 1957, up to twenty five percent at a time of the Under Secretaries to Government in Departments other than the Law Department, who are below ¹[fifty]¹ years of age, may, at the discretion of the Government, be sent outside the Secretariat for field experience.

Provided that the period of such deputation shall be not more than two years and not less than eighteen months.

3. ²[A person sent for field training under rule 2 shall be deemed to have been transferred and shall be eligible for travelling allowance and joining time as admissible under the Karnataka Civil Services Rules. He shall, during the period of training including the joining time, be entitled to the total emoluments which he would have drawn but for such transfer. He shall also be entitled to draw special pay, if any, attached to the post in which he is appointed on such transfer, while he is under such field training”.]².
