NOTIFICATION

No. DPAR 59 SCR 2012, Bangalore, Dated: 06.08.2012

Whereas the draft of the following rules further to amend the Karnataka Civil Services (Computer Literacy Test) Rules, 2012, was published as required by clause (a), sub-section (2) of section 3 of the Karnataka State Civil Services Act, 1978 (Karnataka Act 14 of 1990) in Notification No. DPAR 59 SCR 2012 dated 07.07.2012 in part IV A of the Karnataka Gazette dated 07.07.2012 inviting objections and suggestions from all persons likely to be affected thereby within fifteen days from the date of its publication in the Official Gazette.

Whereas, the said Gazette was made available to the public on 07.07.2012.

And Whereas, no objections and suggestions have been received in this behalf by the State Government.

Now, therefore, in exercise of the powers conferred by sub-section (1) of section 3 read with section 8 of the Karnataka State Civil Services Act, 1978 (Karnataka Act 14 of 1990) the Government of Karnataka hereby makes the following rules, namely:-

RULES

1. Title and commencement:- (1) These rules may be called the Karnataka Civil Service (Computer Literacy Test) (Amendment) Rules, 2012.

(2) They shall be deemed to have come into force with effect from 22.03.2012 (the date on which the main rules have come into effect).

2. Amendment of rule 2:- In the Karnataka Civil Service (Computer Literacy Test) Rules, 2012, for rule 2, the following shall be substituted, namely:-

"2. Applicability in respect of Direct Recruittees.- Notwithstanding anything contained in the Karnataka Civil Services (General Recruitment) Rules, 1977 or the rules of recruitment specially made or deemed to have been made under the Karnataka State Civil Services Act, 1978 (Karnataka Act 14 of 1990) in respect of any service or post, person appointed to any post by direct recruitment in any of the State Civil Services, except the posts specified in sub-rule(3) of rule 1, shall pass the Computer Literacy Test, as may be prescribed by the Government within the period of their probation and the period of probation shall not be declared until he or she passes the said test. The test shall be conducted by the Government or the agency approved by the Government."
