NOTIFICATION

No. DPAR 19 SCR 2006(P), Bangalore, dated 17th April, 2008

Whereas the draft of the Karnataka Civil Services (Direct Recruitment by Competitive Examinations and Selection)(General)(Second Amendment) Rules, 2008 was published as required by clause (a) of Sub-section (2) of Section 3 read with section 8 of the Karnataka State Civil Services Act, 1978 (Karnataka Act 14 of 1990) in Notification No. DPAR 19 SCR 2006(P) dated 13-03-2008 and in Part IV-A of the Karnataka Gazette Extra ordinary dated 14-03-2008 inviting objections and suggestions from all persons likely to be affected there by within thirty days from the date of publication of the draft in the Official Gazette.

Whereas the said Gazette was made available to the public on 14-03-2008.

And whereas no objections and suggestions have been received by the State Government.

Now, therefore, in exercise of the powers conferred by Sub-section (1) of Section 3 read with Section 8 of the Karnataka State Civil Services Act, 1978 (Karnataka Act 14 of 1990) the Government of Karnataka hereby makes the following rules, namely:-

1. Title and Commencement.- (1) These rules may be called the Karnataka Civil Services (Direct Recruitment by competitive Examinations and Selection) (General) (Second Amendment) Rules, 2008.

(2) They shall come into force on the date of their publication in the Official Gazette.

2. Amendment of rule 6.- In the Karnataka Civil Services (Direct Recruitment by Competitive Examinations and Selection)(General) Rules, 2006 in rule 6, after clause (C), the following proviso shall be inserted, namely:-

"Provided that the commission may exempt a candidate from passing the test in Kannada language, if the candidate has passed the Secondary School Leaving Certificate Examination or any examination declared as equivalent thereto by the State Government or any examination higher than the Secondary School Leaving Certificate Examination, in which Kannada is the main language, or the second language or an optional subject (but not one of the subjects in a composite paper) or in which he has studied and passed in Kannada medium, or he has passed the Kannada Language Test conducted by the Commission earlier."
