NOTIFICATION

No. DPAR 34 SCR 2012, Bangalore, dated: 09.07.2013

Whereas the draft of the Karnataka Civil Services (Direct Recruitment by Competitive Examinations and Selection)(General) Rules, 2013, was published as required by clause (a), sub-section (2) of section 3 read with section 8 of the Karnataka State Civil Services Act, 1978 (Karnataka Act 14 of 1990) in Notification No. DPAR 34 SCR 2012 dated;12.03.2013 in part IV A of the Karnataka Gazette Extradinary dated:13.03.2013 inviting objections and suggestions from all persons likely to be affected thereby within fifteen days from the date publication of the draft in Official Gazette.

Whereas, the said Gazette was made available to the public on 13.03.2013.

And Whereas, no objections and suggestions have been received in this behalf by the State Government.

Now, therefore, in exercise of the powers conferred by sub-section (1) of section 3 read with section 8 of the Karnataka State Civil Services Act, 1978 (Karnataka Act 14 of 1990) the Government of Karnataka hereby makes the following rules, namely:-

RULES

1. Title and commencement:- (1) These rules may be called the Karnataka Civil Services (Direct Recruitment by Competitive Examinations and Selection) (General) (Sixth Amendment) Rules, 2013.

(2) They shall come into force from the date of their publication in the Official Gazette.

2. Amendment of rule 5:- In the Karnataka Civil Services (Direct Recruitment by Competitive Examinations and Selection) (General) Rules, 2006, (hereafter referred to as the said rules) for rule 5 and entries relating thereto, the following shall be substituted, namely:-

“5, **Method of Selection:-** The method of selection for direct recruitment under these rules shall be on the basis of percentage of total marks secured in the Competitive Examination and the marks secured in an interview conducted by the Commission under rule 6 in respect of Technical and Non-technical posts.”

3. Amendment of rule 6:- For rule 6 and entries relating there under of the said rules, the following shall be substituted, namely:-

“6 **Selection of Candidates Eligible for Interview:-**(1) The Commission shall conduct a competitive examination in the following manner, namely:-

(a) The examination shall be in the form of objective multiple choice consisting of two written papers carrying 200 marks each , namely:-

(i) Paper-I:- General Paper:- Covering General Knowledge topics relating to Current Events, General Science, Indian History, Indian Geography, Social Sciences, General Mental Ability, matters of every day observation and practical knowledge as may be expected of a person who has passed the prescribed qualifying examination.

(ii) Paper-II:- Specific paper:- The content of this paper shall be determined by the Commission keeping in view the nature of the job for which the selection is being made and the qualifying examination in consultation with the head of the field department or the appointing authority concerned.

(b) The papers shall be set in both Kannada and English.

Provided that if two or more candidates secure equal marks in the competitive examination, the order of merit of such candidates shall be fixed on the basis of their age, the person older in age being placed higher in the order of the merit.

(2) A list of candidates shall be prepared in the order of merit determined on the basis of the percentage of total marks secured by the candidates in the above competitive examination.

(3) Subject to reservation policy of the State, from among the candidates whose names are included in such list such number of candidates as is equal to three times the number of vacancies notified, shall be called for the interview:-

(4) The maximum marks for interview shall be 12.50% of total marks prescribed for the Competitive Examination.”

4. Amendments of rule 8:- For rule 8 and entries relating there under of the said rules, the following shall be substituted, namely:-

“8. Final Selection List of candidates:-(1) The Commission shall prepare a final selection list of candidates eligible for appointment on the basis of merit determined on the basis of percentage of total marks secured in the Competitive Examination and Interview and taking into consideration the reservation policy of the State equal to the number of vacancies notified.

(2) The final selection list prepared under sub-rule (1) shall be published in the Karnataka Gazette and in such other mass media as the Commission may deem fit and in such manner as the State Government may direct and a copy thereof shall be sent to the Appointing Authority concerned, the fact of selection shall be intimated to the candidates selected by the Commission.
