Sub: Residential Telephones to the Ministers,- Issues guidelines for providing the -

READ: G.O.No. DPAR 83 DTN 78 dt.17th August 1978.

FRDA:BLD:

In Government Order read above, certain guidelines were issued in providing Telephone facilities to Ministers/Ministers of State at their residences, as per which, all the Ministers/Ministers of State were eligible for one Telephone with two links at their residence. With a view to have a proper communication between Legislators, offices and Ministers from their residences, Government have decided that all the Ministers of Cabinet rank be provided with two direct telephones at their official residences.

ORDER NO. DPAR 35 DTN 80, BANGALORE DT.22-3-1980.

In this circumstance, Government direct that clause 1 of first para of order portion of the Government Order read above, shall be substituted by the following clause:-

" 1. Each Minister of Cabinet rank will be provided with two telephones each with one or two links and each Minister of State will be provided with one telephone with one or two links, at their official residences".

These orders shall come into force with immediate effect.
