

6. Instructions have been issued in O.M.No. GAD 23 SSR 66 dated 7-10-1966 regarding the procedure to be followed in forwarding the applications of Government servants for recruitment to any other posts under this Government. In such cases, if the competent authority after taking into account the provisions of Rule 5(4) and Rule 11 KCS (General Recruitment) Rules, 1977, decides that the Government servant be permitted to apply, a conditional letter of resignation is not necessary.

It has come to the notice of Government that in some cases the Government servants were not relieved immediately on their appointment in other Departments of this Government although their applications for such appointments had been forwarded by the competent authorities and there was undue delay in relieving them which prevented them from reporting to duty in other Departments within the stipulated time.

When once the applications of a Government servant is forwarded to the KPSC or other Recruiting Authority by the competent authority, the Government servant should be relieved without delay if he is selected and appointed in any other department of this Government.

The Secretaries to Government and Heads of Departments are requested to follow these instructions scrupulously.
