OFFICIAL MEMORANDUM

Subject:- Appointment of candidates selected by the Public Service Commission/ Recruitment Committees- Avoidance of Delay- Instructions.

In Government Circular dated: 31.07.1969 referred to above, it was impressed upon all the appointing authorities for issue of appointment orders to the candidates selected for appointment by the Public Service Commission or Recruitment Committees, within three months from the date of communication of the select list keeping in view the provisions of rule 10 of Karnataka Civil Services (General Recruitment) Rules, 1977. In O.M. dated: 23.11.1974, it was also emphasised that the said period of three months is a sufficiently long period to enable the appointing authorities to consider the suitability of the candidates and that there should normally, be no occasions where a longer period is required. In spite of these instructions, undue delay in making appointment of selected candidates has come to the notice of Government.

2. Government have observed certain cases where there has been considerable delay in obtaining verification reports from the authorities competent to verify the claims made by the candidates as belonging to Backward Groups. The matter has been further examined and the following directions are issued. The appointing authorities shall immediately on receipt of the select list arrange for the verification of character and antecedents of the selected candidates ~~where necessary.~~

Arrangements may also be made simultaneously for the examination of the physical standards of the candidates and also the verification of the claims made by the candidates belonging to the category of Backward Classes through the competent authorities in accordance with the Government Orders cited at (3) and (4) above, respectively. The authorities competent shall furnish the certificates/reports to the appointing authorities within one month from the date of receipt of the communication failing which the matter would be viewed seriously and action shall be taken against the authorities who have failed to furnish the certificates/reports.

3. The Secretaries to Government and the appointing authorities shall take proper and timely action in this connection & ensure that the time limit specified above is strictly adhered to. Government would be constrained to take serious view, if there is undue delay in making appointments of candidates selected by direct recruitment unless there are adequate reasons justifying the delay.
